



The Hedrick City Council met in Special Session on Tuesday, April 21, 2020, in the Library, with Mayor Crawford presiding. Council present: Jeremy Greiner, Kathryn Cernic, Mike Mefford, Tamie Reynolds and Travis Bunnell. Others present: Austin Crowe and John Wehr (via telephone speaker).

The reason for calling the Special Meeting was because the Mayor received a complaint from a citizen about being attacked by his neighbor's dogs. The Sheriff's Office was called and the complaint was made in writing. After guidance from John Wehr, City Attorney, Mefford made a motion to hold an Evidentiary Hearing on Monday, May 4, 2020, at 6 p.m. in the Community Center to determine whether the dogs should be declared vicious or dangerous. Greiner seconded. Roll call – all ayes. Motion carried. Both parties will be sent certified letters to inform them about the Hearing.


Greiner made a motion to adjourn at 7:17 p.m. Reynolds seconded. Roll call – all ayes. Motion carried.
